Credit Transfer/Exemption scheme for JAIIB/CAIIB passed candidates

- ❖ IIBF and IGNOU have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for offering the MBF Programme to the members of IIBF who have passed the JAIIB / CAIIB qualification under the revised syllabi of 2023.
- ❖ IGNOU shall give credit transfer/exemption in MBF programme only for the below specified courses if the candidate completes corresponding subject(s) of JAIIB/CAIIB from IIBF, within the maximum duration of the MBF programme.
- ❖ Out of the 28 courses of MBF programme credit transfer/exemption will be granted upto a maximum of 5 courses as per the courses mapping scheme below:

- ❖ The candidates, who want to take the benefit of credit transfer/exemption, have to take admission into this programme by directly enrolling with IGNOU.
- ❖ The Eligibility Criteria for the MBF program - The candidate should have obtained at least 50% marks (45% in case of reserved category) in the Bachelor Degree/graduation in any subject.
- ❖ Candidates can simultaneously take admission into MBF programme during her/his course of study for JAIIB/CAIIB examinations.
- ❖ Credit transfer will be considered only against the above courses of IIBF which have been revised in the year 2023. (Candidates who have passed JAIIB/CAIIB in the old syllabus are not eligible).
